of an 18th century gobelin**

'WEB OF EUROPE'

The exhibition, “Web of Europe – Contemporary Paraphrases of an Eighteen-Century Brussels Tapestry” will be on display at the Brussels Museum of Art and History (Jubelpark 10, B-1000) from 20th May to 14th August 2011. It was organised by the Dobranyi Foundation of Budapest to celebrate Hungary’s current presidency of the Council of the European Union. The project involved 27 tapestry artists from 14 European countries, each of whom contributed a new and contemporary interpretation of a detail of the Brussels tapestry, “Mercury Hands Over The Infant Bacchus To The Nymphs”. The exhibition will present these details, a documentary of their making and the original tapestry from the Budapest Museum of Applied Arts (<http://www.museumrswyk.nl>).
